Cost: \$2050 which includes registration fees, station/program fees, three meals a day at the field site, room & board at our facility, group chartered transport, and day trip to Tortuguero National Park. Does not include credits, airfare, nor arrival and departure meals or hotel rooms.

2 Locations: Session "A" Clinic at La Suerte: a protected rainforest private sanctuary with rivers, swamps, and abundant plant and animal life. Session "B" Clinic at Tortuguero and training at La Suerte.

Services offered will be funded fully by student tuition, needless to say, this program will be highly beneficial to both the participants and the rainforest communities we service.

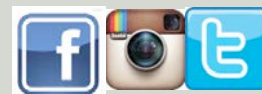
Participation:

Designed for pre-veterinary students in their undergraduate studies. Students will learn about veterinary medicine in a developing country. Along with locals vets, the class will be helping animals in need of medical attention and offer services to horses, cattle, dogs, cats and other animals. Course will cover basic clinical information about diagnostics and treatments including basic veterinary skills such as parasitological surveys, blood work, physical exams and more.
